


Changing the Access Point

To change the Access Point, select **Settings > Advanced Settings > Connection Settings** from the PrivateGSM menu. Restart the application for the change to take effect. PrivateGSM automatically reconnects after the change.

! WAP or MMS access points can not be used.




Exit the application and end the connection to the server

1. Double click on HOME button	2. Long tap on PrivateGSM icon until it starts to wiggle	3. Tap on minus sign to close it

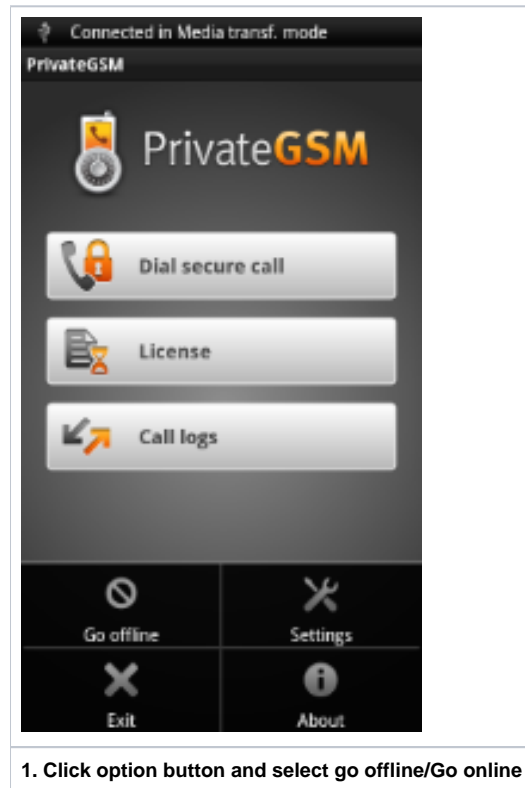

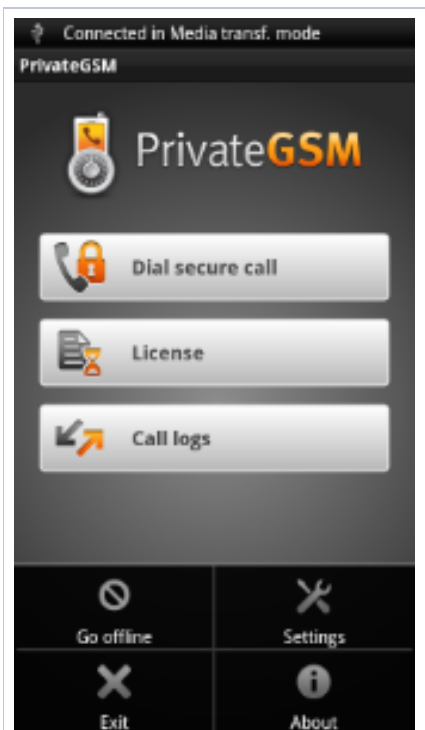
