

# PSAM 1.3 First Access

Once completed the **PrivateServer** installation, you can connect to the **Web console** to perform your preliminary setup.

PrivateServer configure its first NIC with the IP address **10.0.0.100** and subnet mask **255.255.255.0**.

In order to configure the correct IP address of PrivateServer, you must connect your workstation (through cross-cable or network switch), to PrivateServer and configure the IP address of your workstation to 10.0.0.200/255.255.255.0. Then you will be able to reach the PrivateServer administrative interface through the web address <https://10.0.0.100>.



If you can't directly connect to the device or you have no physical access to it (this mostly occur if you are installing on a virtual machine), then you can use your console to configure the network as stated in [PSAM 2.1 Network Configuration](#)



If your server has multiple NIC, please make sure you connect to the correct server NIC (eth0 or the first NIC).

You'll get the login request as shown in fig.1:
