Manual clock configuration is possible from command line, accessing via SSH. Syntax for date command follows pattern MMDDhhmm[[CC]YY][.ss], eg to set clock at 2-nd of July 2012 4:35pm, you use:


Language Configuration

You can set up the language for you PrivateServer. This setting defines which language to speak for any Audio Message played to SIP trunks and to deskphones. Audio messages heard in PrivateGSM are played locally, so they follow the device's locale, not the language chosen on PrivateServer.
